Format for the morning session is:

- Mixed teams
- Approx. minimum team size - 8
- Approx. maximum team size - 16
- Multi skills session

Moderate Learning Difficulties (MLD) - afternoon session:

- 12.30pm - 1.00pm Arrival
- 1.00pm - 2.30pm Round Robin games
- 2.30pm Depart





Format for the afternoon session is:

- Mixed teams
- Approx. minimum team size – 8
- Approx. maximum team size - no maximum, please bring more to sub in and out
- Round robin games

What to Expect?

We are inviting participants to join the festival either in the morning or the afternoon. In the morning, multi skill sessions will be on offer for SLD participants. In the afternoon, we will run a fun cricket competition for MLD participants. Both sessions will be delivered by Devon Cricket coaches.

Clothing & Footwear:

If possible, trainers should be worn and comfy clothing.

Spectators & Guests:

We are not inviting guests or spectators to this event.
